Madiwala Street Vendor Survey - Needs Assessment

BMSSS conducted a Street Vendor Survey at Madiwala on 16th December. The organization conducted this survey to assist the vendors with their needs. It is noticeable to the public eye that the vendors go through a lot of on-site difficulties. The weather at Bangalore has been unforgiving lately, the vendors are no exception to this harsh weather. BMSSS has come forward to understand, analyse and address their needs through working on welfare projects for street vendors.

Disability kit - survey and beneficiary selection

A survey was conducted by BMSSS to figure out the support needed by the differently abled persons. Since most of them live in suffering without being able to manage their everyday livelihood. A detailed study was conducted to assess their immediate needs, so that BMSSS can give out the disability kit to the needful.
